Subject: Decision on the Illinois 2018 Section 303(d) List of Impaired Waters

Dear Mr. Sofat:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has completed its review of Illinois's 2018 Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 303(d) list of water quality limited segments still requiring Total Maximum Daily Load calculations and supporting documentation and information. Based on this review, EPA determined that Illinois's 2018 Section 303(d) list meets the requirements of Section 303(d) of the CWA and EPA's implementing regulations. Therefore, EPA approves Illinois's 2018 Section 303(d) list, which identifies individual waterbody segments with associated pollutants and the State's priority rankings for these segments and pollutants. The statutory and regulatory requirements, and EPA's review of Illinois's compliance with each requirement, are described in the enclosed decision document.
